Plastic Recycling Process



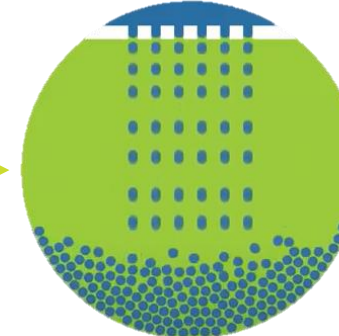
From recycling bin, plastic goes to a **facility** where the different types of plastic are **separated**



Then plastics are shredded and washed.



Afterwards, plastic flakes are melted down and turn into plastic pellets.



Plastic pellets are ready to create new products
